### Stewarding Our Gifts: Go in Peace Glorifying the Lord By Your Life

July 23rd - Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
 Wis 12: 13, 16-19 / Rom 8: 26-27 / Mt 13: 24-43

Today's readings center on the presence of sin in the world. The first reading speaks to the opportunity for repentance, the psalm speaks of forgiveness, Paul writes that the spirit intercedes and guides us toward righteousness, and Jesus uses another parable to teach about the very real presence of evil amongst God's people. As stewards of God's gifts, we are tasked with seeking goodness and truth and allowing the Spirit to dwell within us. We must recognize sin and turn away from it. And when we fail, we must turn back to the Lord in the Sacraments, allowing His gift of grace to restore us!

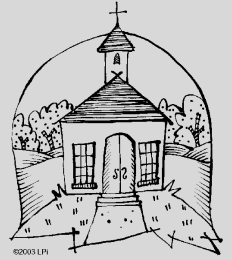
