Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Ex 24: 3-8 / Heb 9: 11-15 / Mk 14: 12-16, 22-26

Today we reflect on Jesus' gift of self: His body and His blood. In *Evangelii Gaudium*, Pope Francis refers to the Eucharist as "a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak." Throughout the Gospels, Jesus made a habit of feeding his followers, and the Eucharist became the most important source of nourishment he offered! As stewards of the church -- the Body of Christ -- we may not like to admit our weaknesses, but they are real and the Eucharist exists to remedy our ailments. Hebrews 9:15 says that "those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance." Through our baptism, we are ALL called into the service of the Lord and into His eternal inheritance. As we celebrate the Eucharist with one another, allow the Eucharist to move, heal us, and nourish!

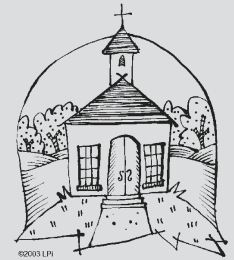
