## Stewardship Message— “Who are you Following?”

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Ez 2:2-5 / 2 Cor 12:7-10 / Mk 6:1-6

Faith takes the center stage for a second week in a row! In the reading from Ezekiel, we learn that the Israelites were hard of heart and literally needed to be saved from themselves. In the Gospel we hear that Jesus' own family and friends were in the same sad situation. They knew who He was, and yet they questioned Him! To be a true steward it requires more than mere knowledge of who Jesus is! It requires focused effort and constant conversion of heart. It requires prayer and a personal relationship with Jesus. Only then will your faith be great enough to allow the miraculous healing Jesus is capable of. Do not allow your discipleship to grow stale. Instead, make every effort to open your heart and allow your faith to flourish!

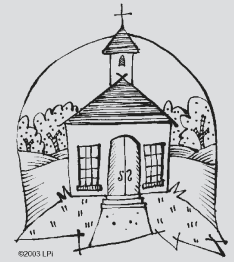
