Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Deut 4:1-2, 6-8 / Jas 1:17-18, 21-22, 27 / Mk 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

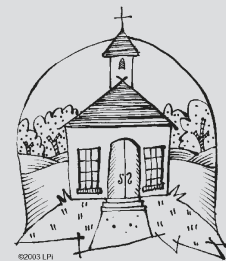
