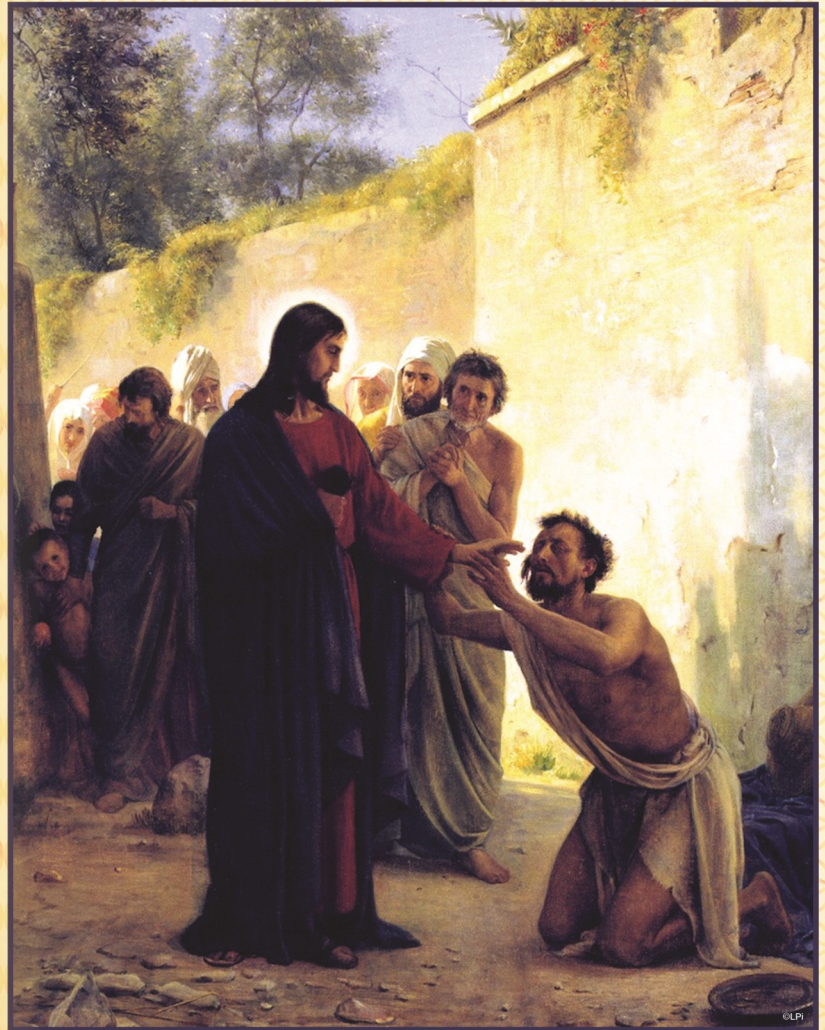

### Stewardship Message—

**"Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples"**

**Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Jer 31:7-9/ Heb 5:1-6 / Mk 10:46-52

"Take courage; get up, Jesus is calling you." This statement from today's gospel might be a wakeup call to each and every one of us. It is nearly time for us to recommit our gifts of time, talent, and treasure for the coming year. How is Jesus calling you to do so? And how will you respond? The blind man in this gospel passage desperately wants to see, and he knows that Jesus can heal him. He has great faith! However, the people around him rebuke him for calling out to Jesus and make him feel unworthy. How often does the world do this to us? We should encourage one another to call out to Jesus - we should all be blessed with the gift of sight that only He can provide! In the coming week, find a moment of silence when you can shut out the noise of the world and listen for Jesus' call. And may you respond with the same enthusiasm as the man in the Gospel: "He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus."

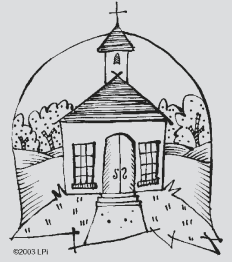
