“Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples”

First Sunday of Lent

Deut 26:4-10 / Rom 10:8-13 / Lk 4:1-13

In dealing with playground bullies, we often to tell children to stand up and defend themselves rather than giving the power to the bully. Satan, like the playground bully, wants to draw you away from the safety and confidence God gives you. In today's gospel, we see Jesus standing up for Himself. By not falling for Satan's trickery, Jesus has taken all of his power away which caused him to "depart for a time." And now here we are, at the beginning of our own temptation in the Lenten "desert." As we strive to cleanse our hearts and prepare for Easter Sunday, Satan will do all he can to derail our efforts. In baptism, we were given the spiritual weapons to fight the evil one. Now is the time to tap into those gifts -- ask the Holy Spirit to make you FULLY ALIVE as you begin your Lenten journey.

Lenten Retreat for Persons with Disabilities – April 13

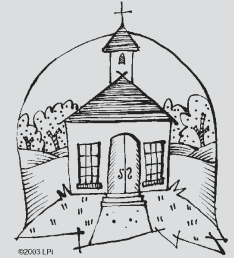
