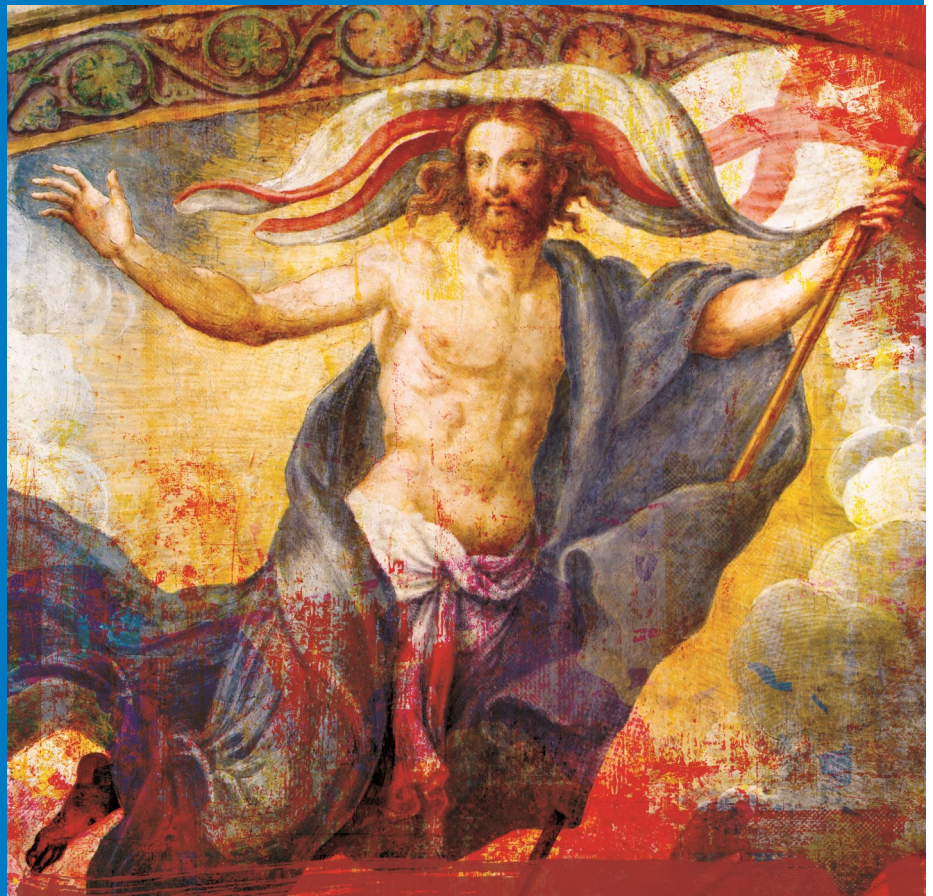

Stewardship Message— "Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples" Acts 10:34A, 37-43, Col 3:1-4 Jn 20:1-9

He is Risen! Alleluia! Today is a perfect day to stop and quietly reflect on this year's Stewardship poster. You can likely find one posted in your church, or perhaps you have the image at home. In it we have the Easter sunrise, and we see Peter and John as they are running to tell the other disciples that Jesus is no longer in the tomb. It is the perfect illustration for today's Gospel. Peter's face shows awe and wonder, while John's expression is one of love and concern. In both of their faces, we can see Jn 20:9, "For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead." Where do you place yourself in this image? Perhaps you are standing along the side of the road, watching them run past you. Maybe you are running right next to them. Maybe you are at home, just waking up to hear the news. What emotions are shown on your face as you come to realize that Jesus is ALIVE?! How will you go about your day, the coming week, or the rest of your life knowing that because of Jesus' resurrection, you are also FULLY ALIVE?

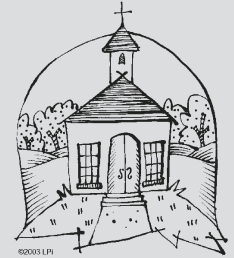
