### Stewardship Message—

“Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples”

Fourth Sunday of Easter

Acts 13:14, 43-52 Rev 7:9, 14B-1Jn 10:27-30

Today’s brief reading from the Gospel of John gets straight to the heart of discipleship. A disciple is a follower and must know who and what he is following. Jesus says, “My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me.” What parts of your daily routines allow you to hear and know the voice of your shepherd? Do you spend time reading scripture? Do you seek his voice in your quiet prayer time? Our world is a noisy one, and we have to be intentional about clearing out the clutter and following the voice that promises us eternal life. Like sheep, humans tend to function best in groups. Perhaps you need a small discipleship group to help you stay in range of the Shepherd’s voice? You might try a Bible study or a prayer group. Look for opportunities throughout your day when you can check in with the Good Shepherd! You can’t follow a voice you can’t hear!

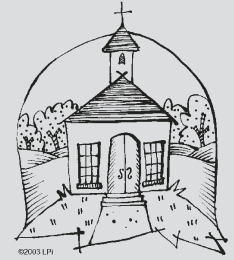
