“Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples”

Fifth Sunday of Easter

Acts 14:21-27 Rev 21:1-5A Jn 13:31-33A, 34-35

“As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” As we consider our roles as missionary disciples, it may be easy to turn it into a j-o-b... full of tasks and to-do lists. Give of yourself! Say your prayers! Read your Bible! Minister to those in need! Go to Mass! Sign up for a new ministry! Make a salad for the funeral! Do this! Don't forget that! These things are all very important parts of our stewardship, but today Jesus reminds us that basic discipleship is actually very simple. He tells us to love one another — authentically and publically. If we are doing so, all of those other pieces will happen naturally, and out of love. So rather than looking at stewardship as a list of things to do today, simply seek to love well.

TOTUS TUUS

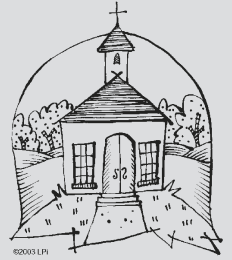

St. Mary's Cemetery Memorial Day Decorations
