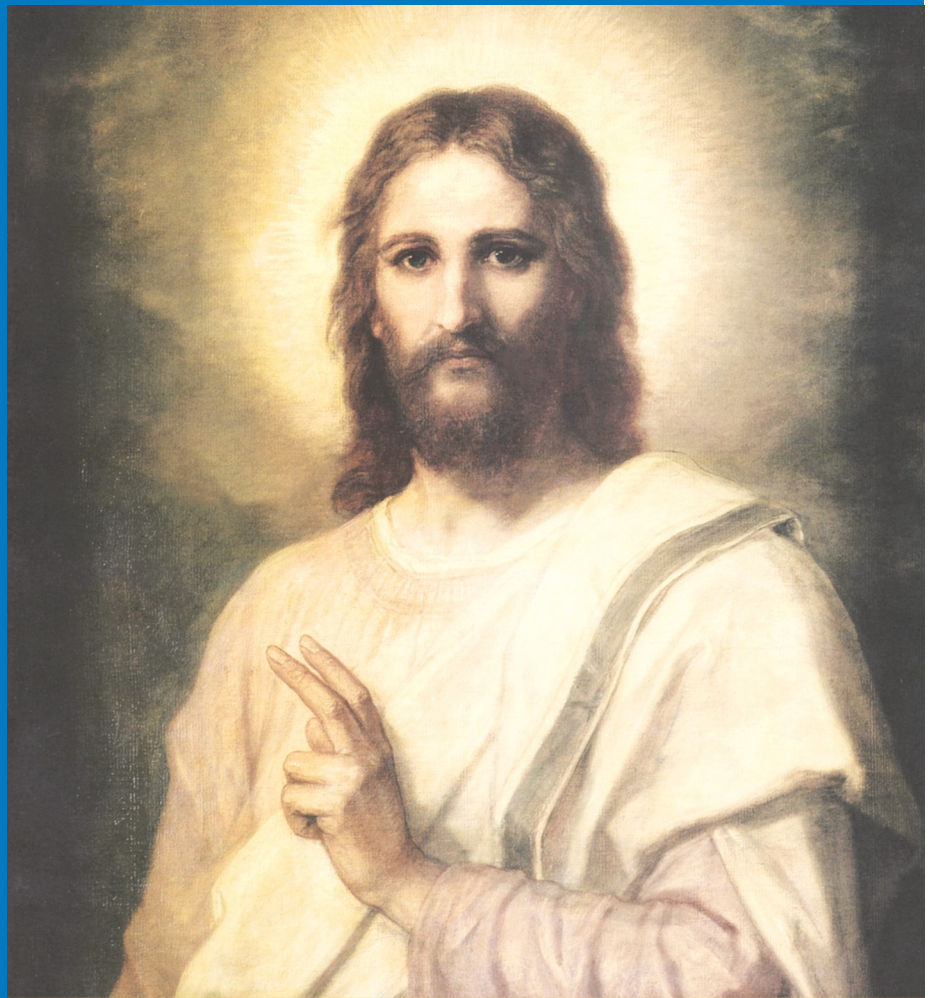

### Stewardship Message—

**“Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples”  
Sixth Sunday of Easter**

Acts 15:1-2, 22-29 Rev 21:10-14, 22-23 Jn 14:23-29

As He did last week, Jesus speaks again today of the importance of love: “Whoever loves me will keep my word...” [Let us remember that in the opening passage of John’s Gospel, ‘word’ refers to Jesus Himself!] Jesus assures the disciples that they will see Him again, but what He means is that He will be recognizable within them because of their mutual love and respect. As missionary disciples, we also carry Jesus within us and that should be clear to others by our words and our deeds. A well-known church hymn says, “...we’ll guard each man’s dignity and save each man’s pride and they’ll know we are Christians by our love.” Sometimes love is a kind smile or a well-timed hug. Other times it is more aggressive — standing up for the “unlovable” as Saint Theresa did, or working to find empathy for your own enemy. We are called to change the world, which is a monumental task that can only be accomplished through love. Allow the love of Jesus, which dwells within YOU, to pour forth upon those you encounter.

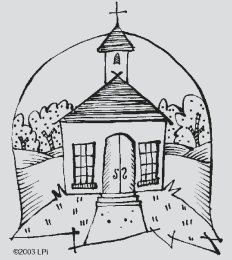
