Stewardship Message— “Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples”

The Ascension of the Lord
Acts 1:1-11 Eph 1:17-23 Lk 24:46-53

Acts 1:5: “...for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” This verse from the first reading might cause us to take pause and consider the difference between the two kinds of baptism. Is one inferior to the other? The word baptism comes from a Greek word meaning “to immerse.” John preached a message of repentance, and his baptism — an immersion in water — was an outward mark of that repentance. Jesus, however, spoke of a baptism in the Holy Spirit, one that plunges people deeper into the Kingdom of God. When we reflect on our own baptism, we must consider both aspects: the water as a sign of repentance and the Spirit, which compels us to know and proclaim the Kingdom of God. As baptized Christians, we are certainly Fully Alive, but we must consciously choose to be Missionary Disciples. Like Jesus, we have to allow our baptism to open our hearts and our minds to God’s will. A good steward means cooperating with His will.

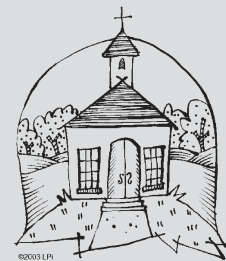
