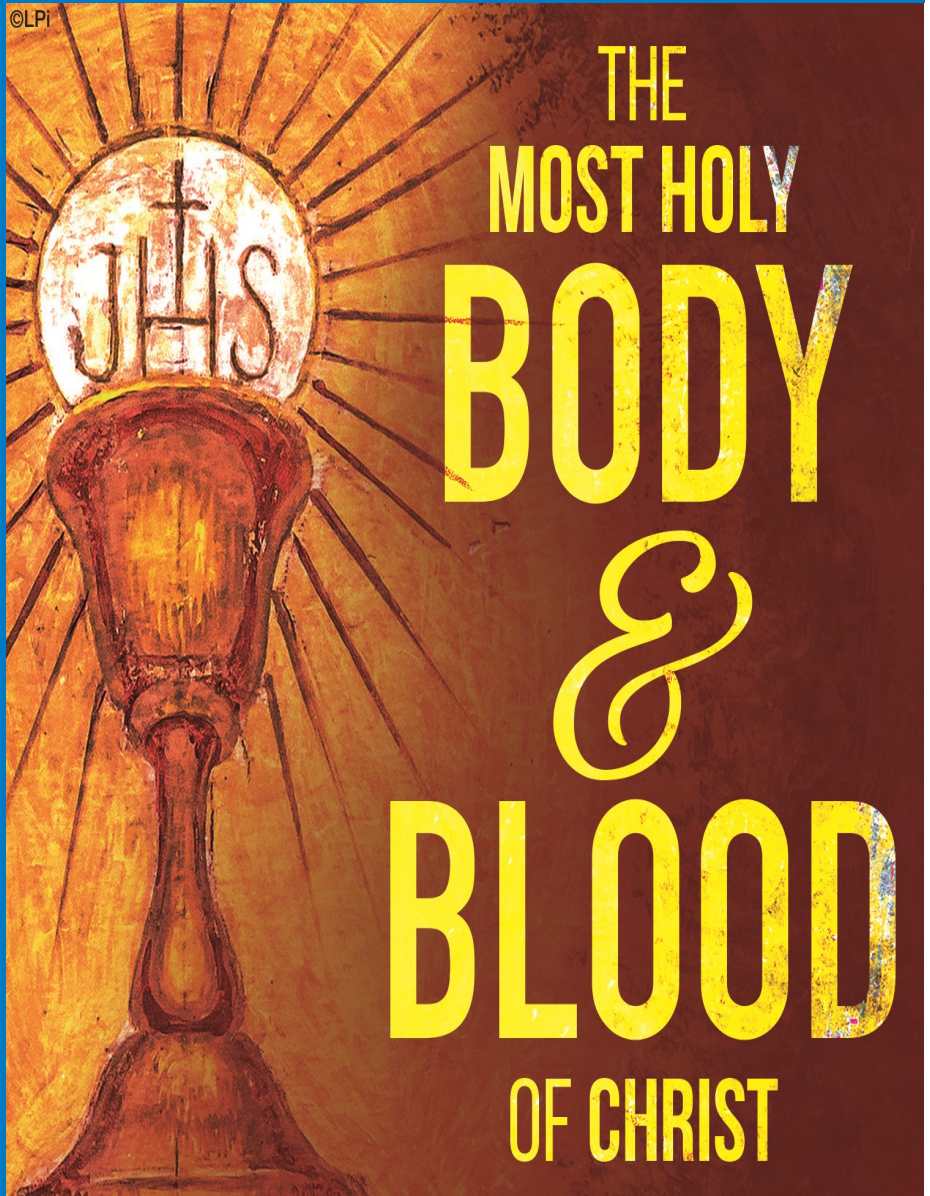

Stewardship Message—

“Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples”

Gen 14:18-20 Rev 1 Cor 11:23-26 Lk 9:11B-17

“Five loaves and two fish are all we have.” The disciples do not have much faith that they can feed five thousand people on such a meager offering, and they are right to feel that way. No human could feed “the multitude” on such a small amount. But Jesus does not seem concerned with the small amount of food they have to offer. He takes this food, which is barely enough to feed five people, and He proceeds to satisfy the hunger of thousands of people — with leftovers!! This is a miracle, to be sure. For humans this was impossible, but for God it is not out of character. We can consider this, then, when we look at our own offerings as stewards. How many times do we withhold the dollar in our pocket because it is too small a gift to put in the collection basket? How often do we opt out of the hymns at Mass because we don’t really sing that well anyway? Or maybe we choose not to sign up for a holy hour because what difference would sixty minutes of prayer really make in our lives? Do not underestimate God’s ability to take your meager offering and work miracles!!

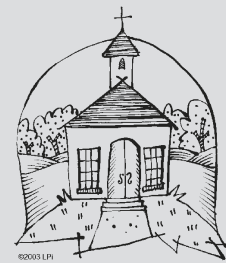
