Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Am 6:1A, 4-7 1 Tim 6:11-16 Lk 16: 19-31

In today's first reading from the Prophet Amos, we find a group of wealthy men living a life of luxury. They have been given much — comfort, food, wine, music, and companionship. Yet they have become too accustomed to their lifestyle. Amos calls them complacent, meaning they no longer understand that they have been abundantly blessed. They have been empowered in many ways but are abusing the gifts rather than sharing them. They are not unlike the wealthy man in the Gospel today. That man died and was cast into the netherworld, where he suffered great torment. The reality is that most of us are also like the wealthy men in these stories. We have been abundantly blessed, but we take our blessings for granted. We are complacent, and we need to snap out of it before it is too late! Ask the Holy Spirit to create in you a sense of gratitude and a desire to use your blessings for the good of others!

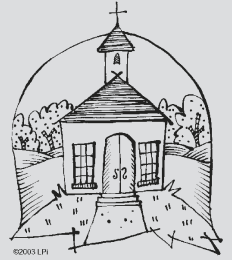
