Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Hab 1:2-3, 2:2-4; 2 Tim 1:6-8, 13-14; Lk 17:5-10

How often do you pray for faith? For many of us, the answer may be rarely, or even never. In today’s gospel we see the apostles asking for an increase in faith, which may seem odd as one would think they might be the most faithful of Jesus’ followers. Jesus responds in saying that if they had even the tiniest amount of faith they could move mountains. I imagine this response surprised them, as it would you and I. While this answer may cause us to question our own faith, we must remember that faith is a gift of the Holy Spirit. If we want to be EMPOWERED with more faith, we must ask the Holy Spirit to help us use that gift. This week, pray for an increase in faith, and watch how the Holy Spirit creates change in your heart! “...the just one, because of his faith, shall live.” (Hab 2:4)

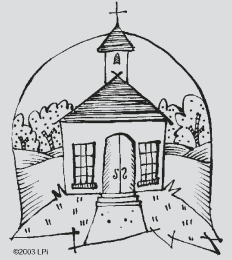
