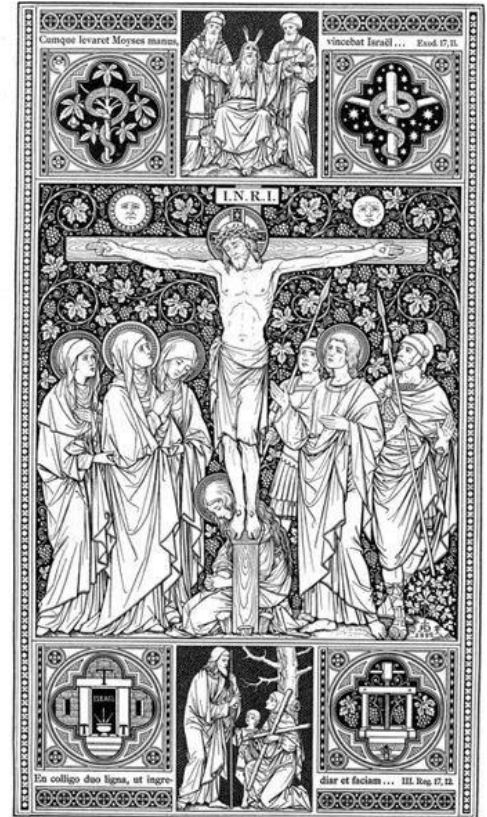
**Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at 6:00 p.m. at St. Mary Newton**

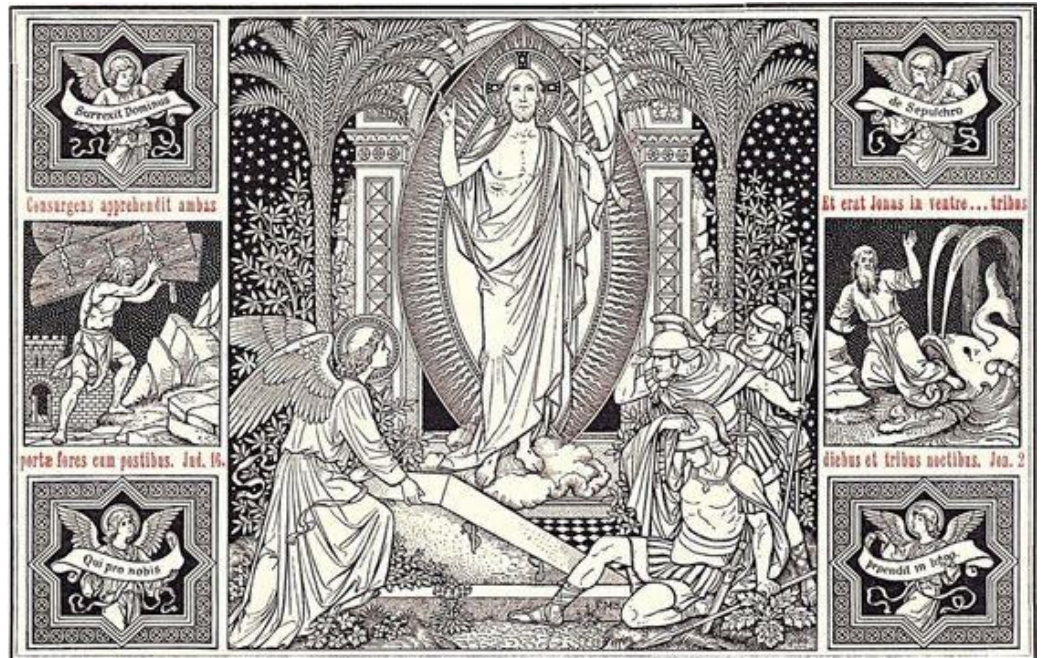
**THE EASTER VIGIL, April 16<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 p.m. at St. Mary Newton**

**EASTER SUNDAY, APRIL 17<sup>TH</sup> 2022**

*Mass is to be celebrated on Easter Day with great solemnity. It is appropriate that the penitential rite on this day take the form of a sprinkling with water blessed at the Vigil, during which the antiphon "Vidi aquam" or some other song of baptismal character should be sung along with the renewal of our Baptismal promises. Easter Water in bottles will be available after the Masses.*
