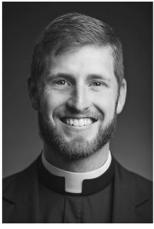

Bishop Kemme addressed the pastors and principals of schools earlier this month and he expressed his great displeasure that the Value Them Both amendment did not pass. But he said this only means that we must continue the fight to protect the unborn and work for the conversion of society.

On that note, I would like to present an opportunity to pray for the unborn, especially those threatened by abortion. The Venerable Fulton Sheen wrote a prayer to let the faithful know that we are not powerless against anti-life forces. He wanted us to know that, someday, in heaven, we will embrace the babies whom we have spiritually adopted. The prayer is:

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the unborn baby [baby's name] that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion. Amen.

The Spiritual Adoption Program is one which many dioceses and parishes promote and which countless families participate in. The purpose of the Spiritual Adoption Program is threefold:

- Encourages individuals in parishes, schools and CCW's to pray for babies in danger.
- Educates adults and children about the 9 month development of the pre-born child.
- Provides mothers in need with donated baby gifts from a shower held in the 9th month.

This is a great way for families to pray for the unborn and to learn about the amazing development of their spiritually adopted baby in the womb. Participants are asked to sign a pledge card and name the child for whom they will be praying for each day for nine months.

The Adventure lasts for 40 weeks and includes email updates on the development of the baby, links to fun and educational material. A parishioner (Candace de Barbantin) will be available after Mass on the weekend of Sept. 10/11 to answer questions and help you get signed up.

St. Vincent de Paul Reflection

"The story of St. Vincent's life is the story of continual conversion to discipleship, a continual dying to self. Vincent life is a story of continual turning towards Someone. That Someone is the person of Jesus Christ as He is made known in the Gospel. Vincent kept turning towards Jesus and towards the poor. That must also become the story of our life. St. Vincent often gave his followers a guiding principle in the practice of frequently stopping during the day in order to ask the simple question:

"What would Jesus Christ do or say if He were in the circumstances in which I find myself now?"
