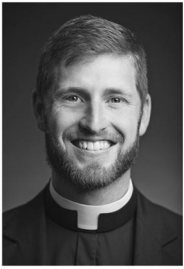

A GREAT OPPORTUNITY

Please consider for a moment what I believe is a unique opportunity we have to financially help our Catholic schools in the diocese. It is unique in that if you donate more than you owe in state income tax, it is possible that everything you would have paid for state income tax goes to Catholic schools in our diocese. You simply have to make a special financial gift to the 'Support for Catholic Schools' program. There's a minimum contribution of \$500, but you will receive a 70% state tax credit for any gift of \$500 or more. For example, if you owe \$350 in state income taxes this year, a \$500 contribution by you would ultimately only cost you \$150 because you no longer owe the \$350 in state income taxes (70% of \$500). This is a relatively new program that is operated by the Diocese. Through this program the state of Kansas grants a 70% income tax credit for all donations given, but the **entire** donation goes to our Catholic schools.

Another way of looking at it is that by making a special gift beyond your normal tithe, you can redirect what you are going to pay the state in taxes to Catholic schools. So by paying a little more than what you owe in taxes, you're able to redirect tax dollars from the state of Kansas to our Catholic schools.

A business can participate in this program as well, and direct their state corporate income tax to Catholic schools in the same way.
