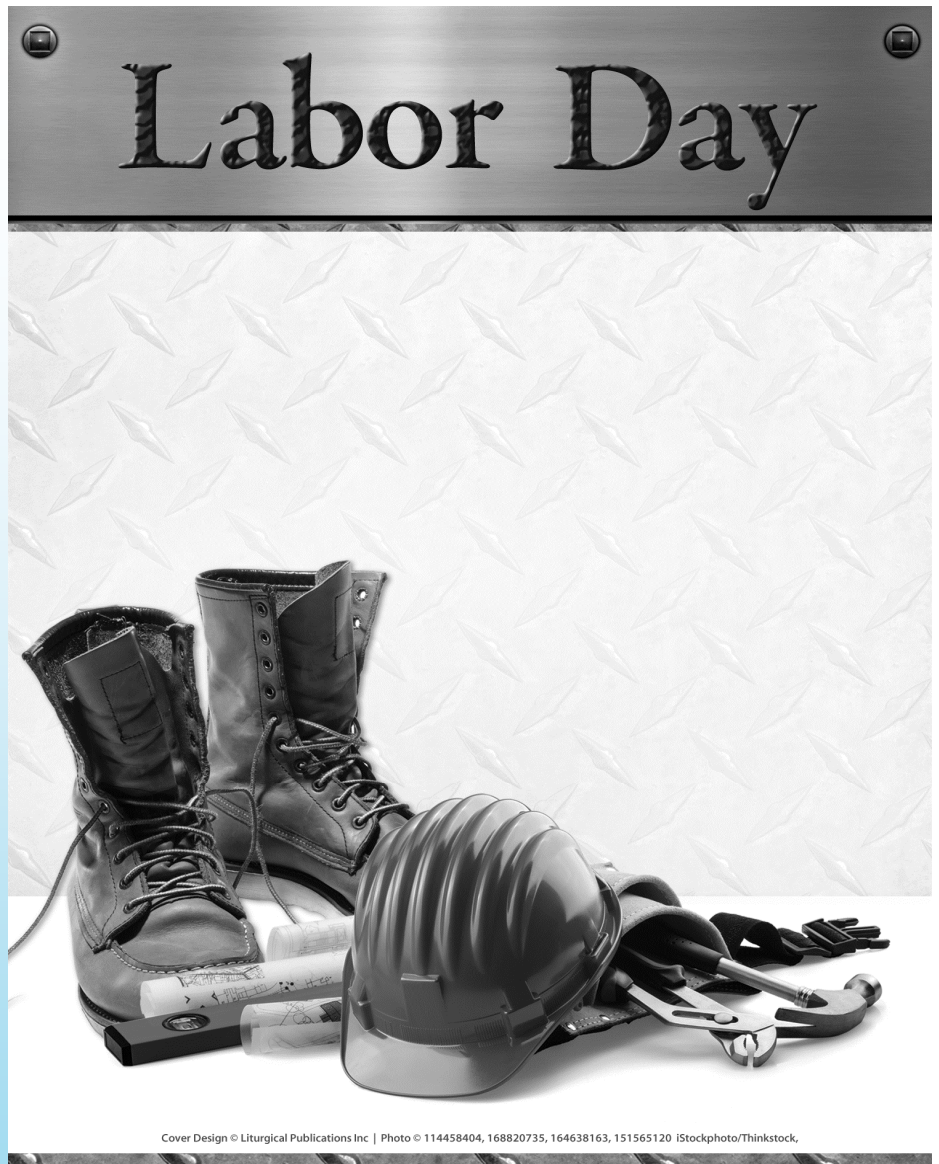

Stewardship Message - Sept. 1, 2013

"What Gifts Do I Share?"

The Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time
The book of Sirach in the Old Testament offered advice to the Israelites to help them in many areas of daily living. Today's lesson includes a reminder to practice humility. In the Gospel, Jesus presents a parable to illustrate humility applied in social situations. It is easy to understand Jesus' teaching on sharing material gifts to provide comfort to the poor and downtrodden. It is not as easy to understand and apply virtues of humility, obedience and fear of the Lord in today's culture. When we exercise such a virtue, we can offer ourselves to be used by God to help others find their way to Him. May we remember Jesus' words and actions at all times and allow our lives to be a light to others.

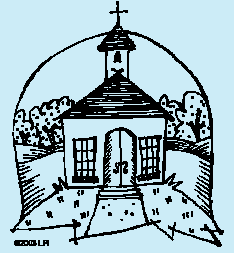
