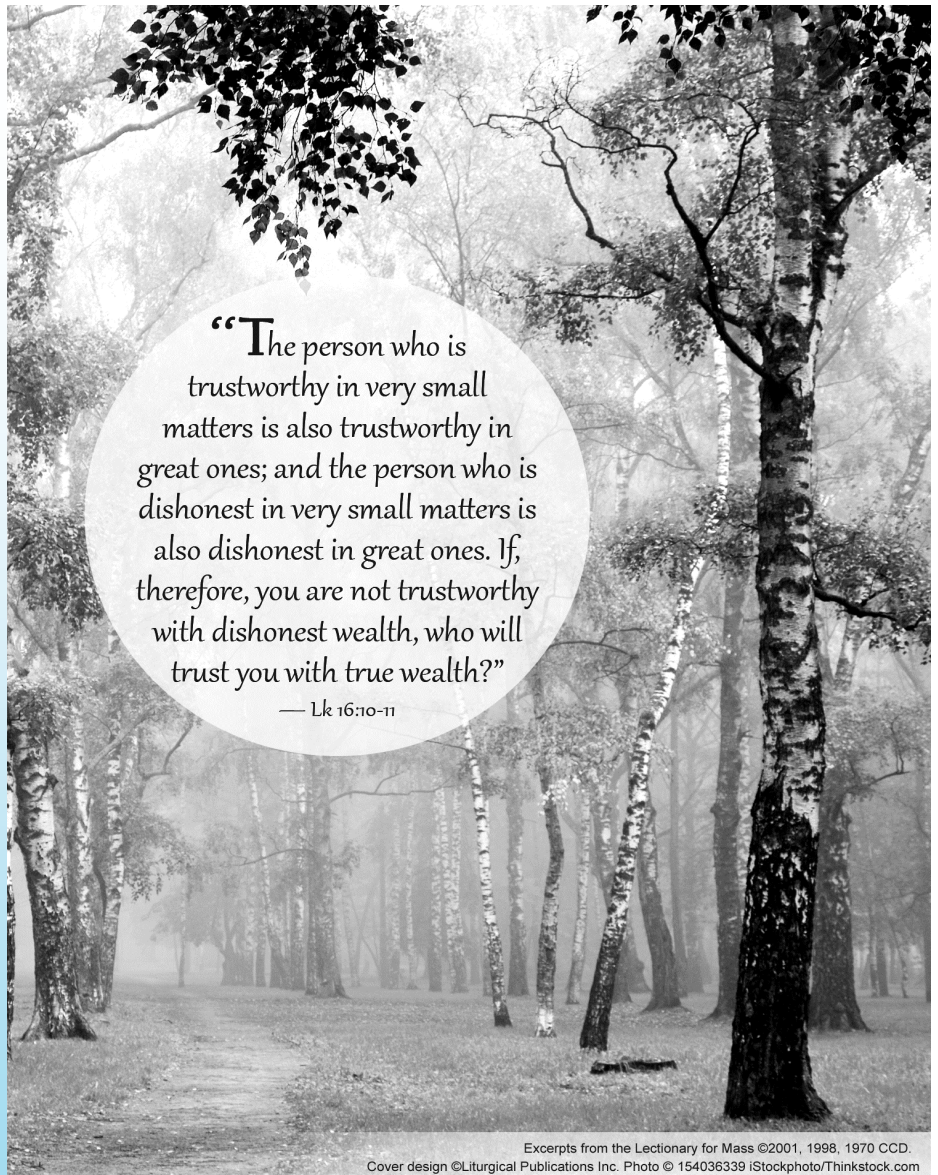

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

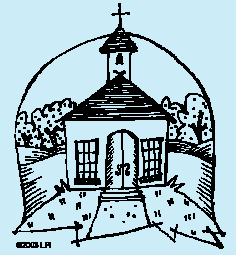
In an emergency of serious illness, if sick and confined to a home, entering a hospital or local nursing home - please notify the rectory.
