"What Gifts Do I Share?"

Today's readings concern the recognition of God's gifts. The prophet Habakkuk was told by God to have patience, those with faith would live. St. Mary Catholic School has an official enrollment of 173 preschool - 8th grade students for the 2013-14 school year. The official count date for the state of Kansas is September 20. That is up 2 from last year when there were 171 students. The ethnicity of St. Mary students is: 52.6% Caucasian, 41.0% Hispanic, 4.6% African American, and 1.7% Asian. The free/reduced count is 51.1%. This will again qualify St. Mary as a Title I and Drexel Fund school. Thank you to those who were able to come to the window dedication in honor of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph.
