"What Gifts Do I Share?"

The Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

The prophet Malachi warned the evildoers in Israel's time that the day of the Lord would come unexpectedly and punish them for their deeds while the righteous would be rewarded. In Jesus' time he spoke of the destruction of the temple and those around him wanted to receive a warning. Like Jesus' disciples, we long to know ahead of time that the end is near. Jesus warned his disciples to not be deceived by false prophets and to always be prepared. Our preparation is rooted in how we live each day with the abundance of God's creation. May our concern for each other's journey to heaven influence us to live in the here and now, placing our gifts at the service of the Lord.

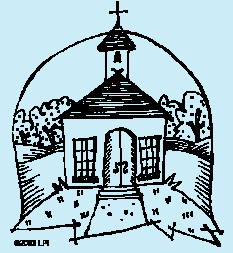
