Legion of Mary

The Legion of Mary will be **piloting a new program for the next four (4) months called the Rosary Service Program.**

Once a month, on varying days of the month, so that all might have an opportunity to attend, we gather as a parish community for prayer, in the church. In the vestibule, there will be a basket with envelopes, with a Legion label, that you might write a personal intention. Place your **private intention in the envelope, seal it, and place in the basket.** The basket will be placed before the altar prior to the service. Once the rosary service is over, **the sealed envelopes will be shredded by a Legion representative. Privacy will be maintained.** Basket will remain in the vestibule. Prayers to include Rosary, Readings, Responsorial Psalms, Divine Chaplet, Tessera Prayers, various Litanies. **Tentative dates are 1/21/14, 2/17/14, 3/1/14. Services at 6:30pm respectively, March service after 8:00 am Mass.**

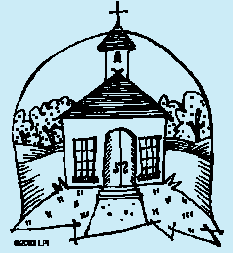
