**"What Gifts Do I Share?"**

Presentation of the Lord

Today is the feast of the Presentation of the Lord. The Gospel reading is the story of Jesus' presentation at the temple in Jerusalem, a ritual performed by devout Jews when their first born is a son. At his presentation Jesus is revealed as the Messiah to Simeon by the Holy Spirit. The reading from the Letter to the Hebrews tells us that Jesus shared in the flesh and blood of humankind in order to bring God's salvation to them. Jesus' kingship was foretold by the prophet Malachi, who reminds us that the Lord will test us and purify us, that we may enter the kingdom. May we accept Jesus as a gift from God and offer ourselves to Him in gratitude.

Service at 6:30pm in Feb. and March service after 8:00 am Mass.**

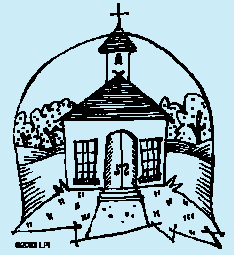
