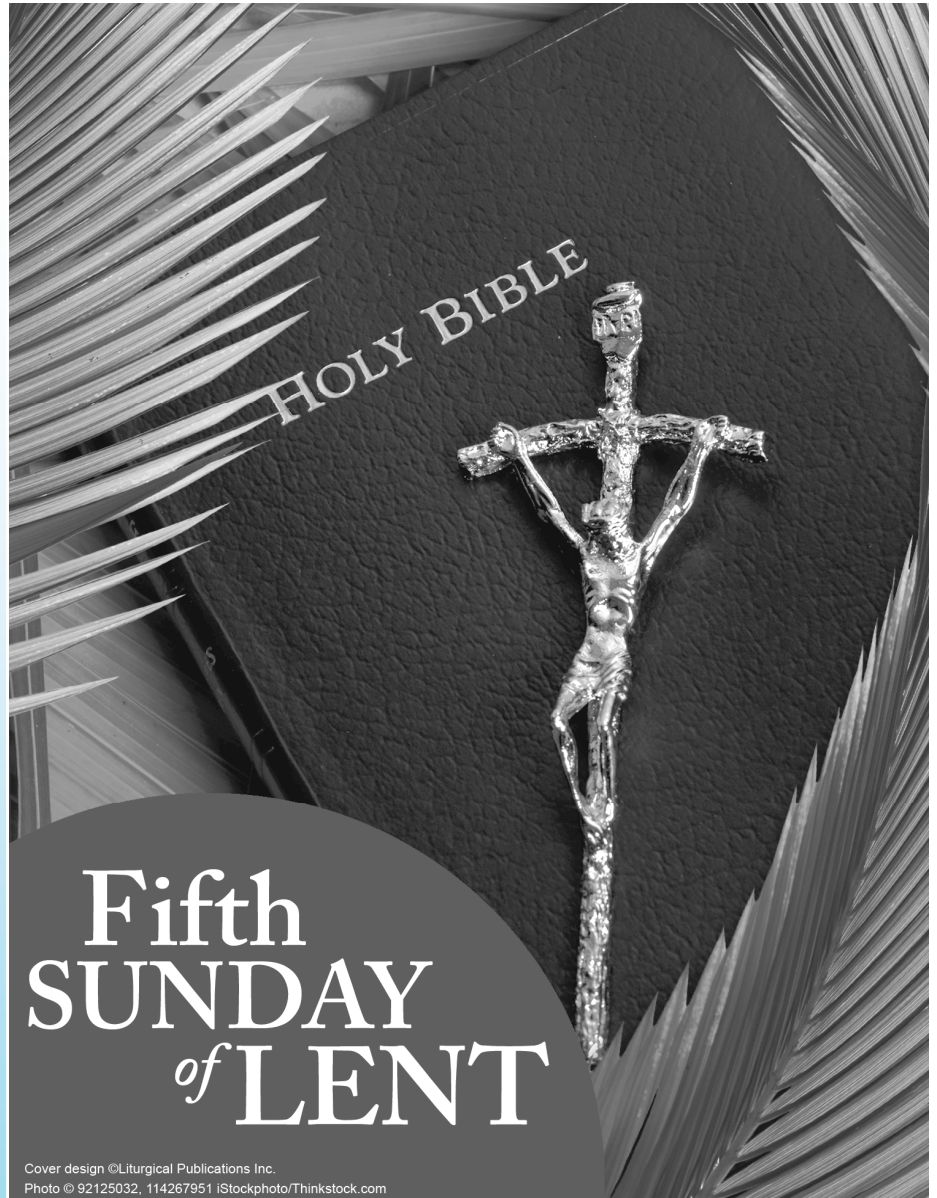

## Stewardship Message - April 6, 2014

*"What Gifts Do I Share?"*

Fifth Sunday of Lent

What gift do I share? Today we are called to reflect on the life God freely gives us. The prophet Ezekiel pleads with the people to make them understand the depth of God's love. His love will raise people from their graves and give life to them. With the same pleading, St. Paul exhorts us to live for Christ that the Spirit may dwell in our hearts. The Gospel story of Lazarus being brought back to life is a story of love. Jesus loved Lazarus and his sisters and consequently was deeply moved by the sisters' sorrow. He wept. He weeps for us too, when we find ourselves in distress because we excluded him from our lives. As the Author of Life, Jesus can strengthen and give direction to our lives if we will but share with Him. May we live our lives in joy, hand in hand with the Lord!

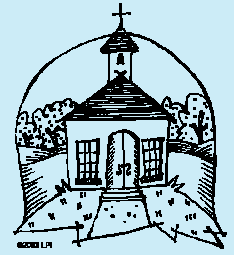
