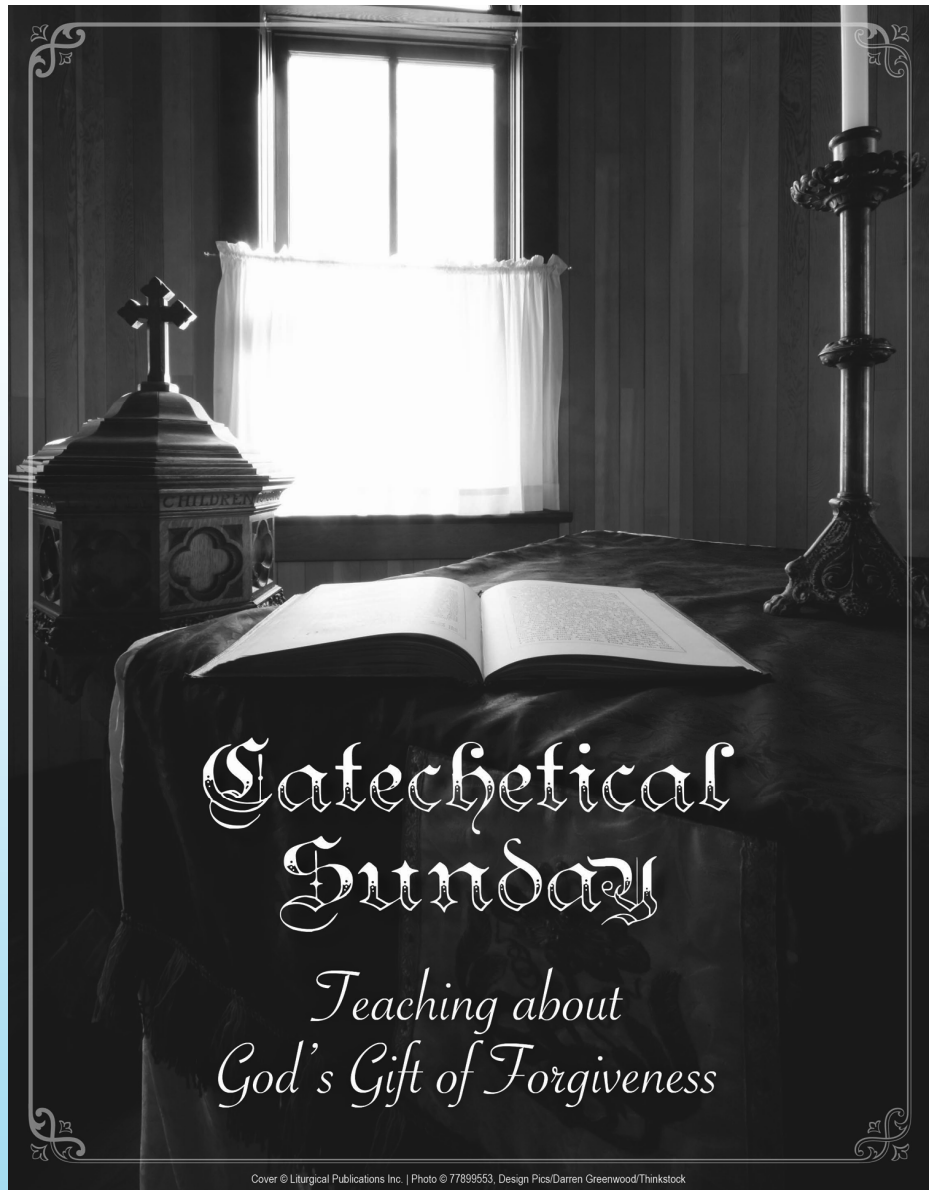

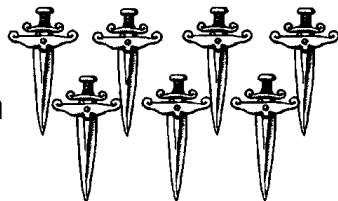

Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

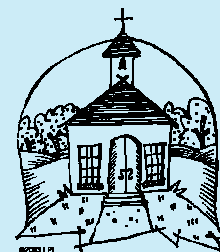
