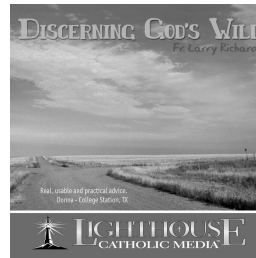

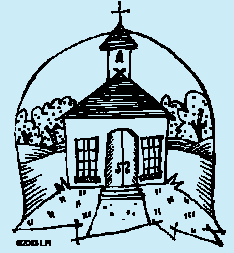

Sacrament of Reconciliation

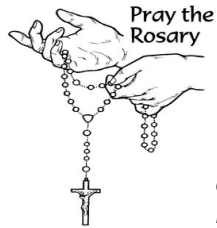

October: The Month of the Rosary

There are several special days in October, but one of the more important days, is October 7th, Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. The rosary is the principle weapon to reform the world, and was once called the Angelic Psalter. Saint Dominic received the Angelic Psalter from Our Lady, mostly in its present form in 1214, as a means of conversion of the Albigensians and sinners of the world.
