## Stewardship Message - Oct. 19, 2014

### "The Joy of the Gospel: Faith Working Through Love"

Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

You are chosen! The Lord God chooses certain men to carry out his purposes. While the Israelites were languishing in exile, the Lord chose Cyrus, the king of Persia, to be the instrument of their emancipation. King Cyrus allowed the Israelites to return to their homeland. St. Paul tells the Thessalonians that they were chosen to receive the message of the Gospel. The love of God the Father shines in these events and builds up the faith of the people who are the direct recipients. In today's Gospel, the Pharisees put faith in their own cunning and try to trap Jesus. Although the Pharisees chose Caesar to ensnare Jesus, God used Caesar to show the Pharisees how they were corrupting the word of the Lord. May the Word of God come to us and may we be chosen to spread it to all nations.

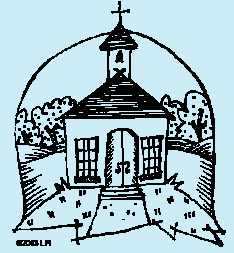
