Zeal for your house will consume me! Both the Old and New Testaments refer to the Temple of God. In the Old, the prophet Ezekiel reminds the Israelites of the blessings poured out through God's holy temple. Water flowing out from the temple brings abundant life wherever it goes. In the Gospel of John, Jesus challenges the Jewish leaders in their treatment of the temple and delivers the idea that His body is a temple. 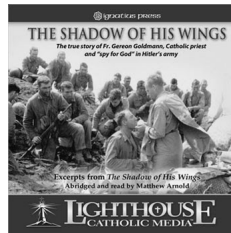

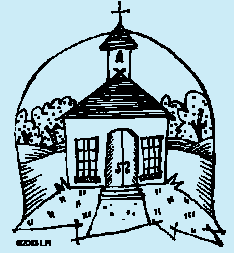
