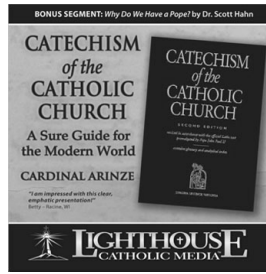

Rachel's Vineyard is an intense weekend retreat offered by our Salina Diocese, for those who have been affected by an abortion.

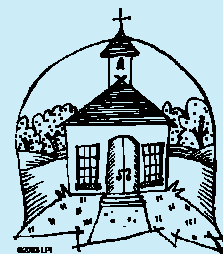
