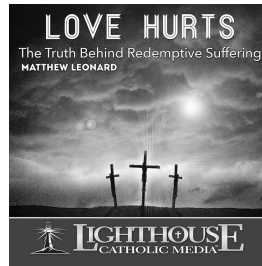
Stewardship Message-May 10, 2015

Sixth Sunday of Easter

This I command you: Love one another! Jesus' words in today's Gospel demand our attention. I chose you. I appointed you to go and bear fruit. Love one another. 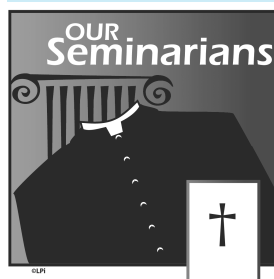
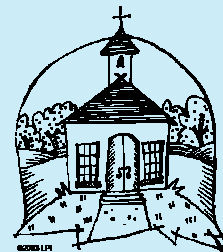
