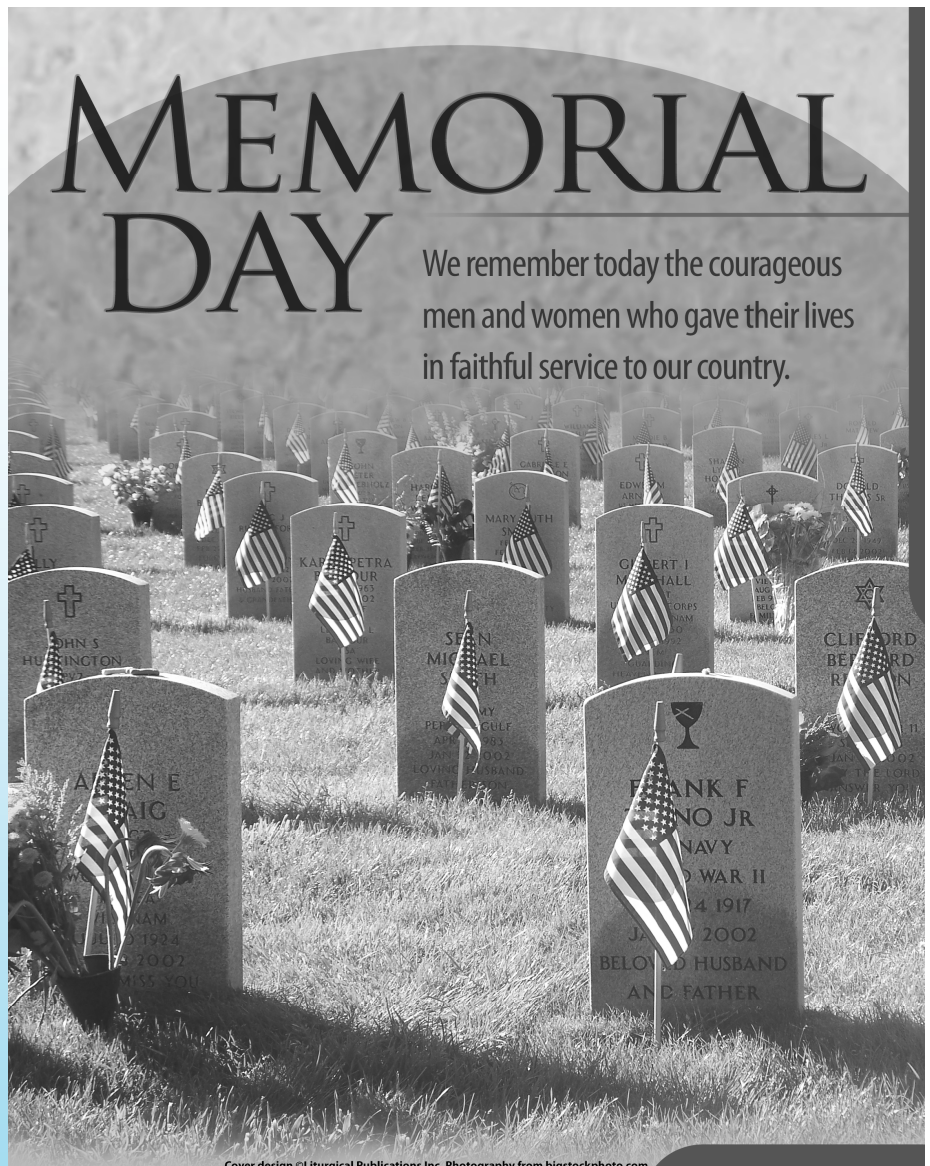

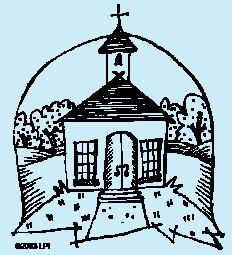

Catholic Man Night

Dear Men of the Parish:

Are you a man of hope? Are you looking for hope? 1 Peter 3:15 says:..... *Sanctify Christ as Lord of your hearts. Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope...* The hope that 1 Peter is speaking about is not confidence in human achievement or excellence. It is about Christian hope. Christian hope gives courage to endure affliction and might to stand against adversity. It provides confidence in God who is *rich in mercy*.
