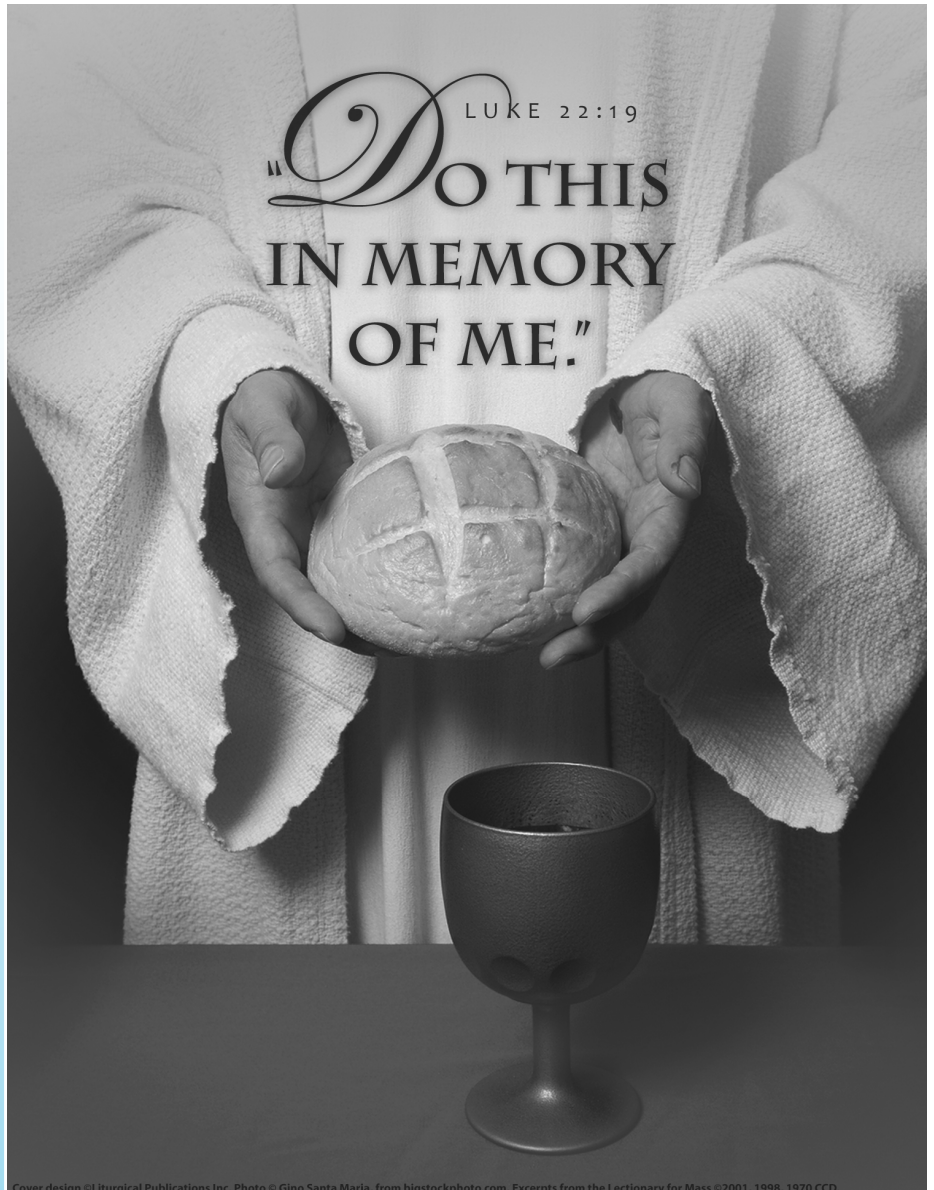

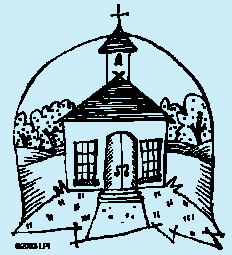

Dear Men of the Parish:

Are you a man of hope? Are you looking for hope? 1 Peter 3:15 says:..... *Sanctify Christ as Lord of your hearts.
