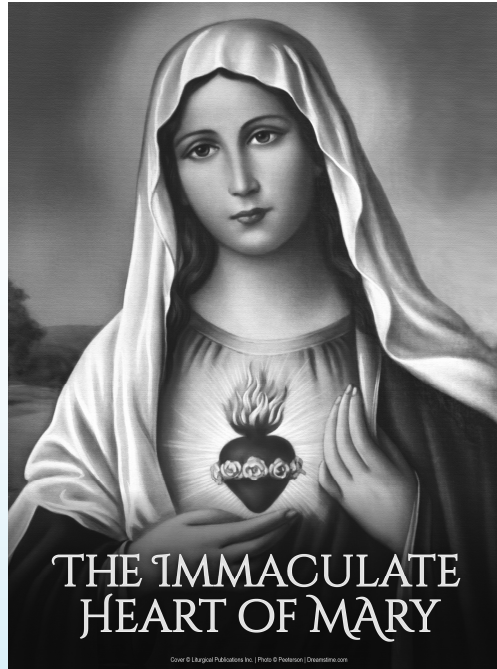

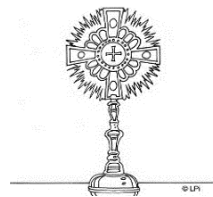

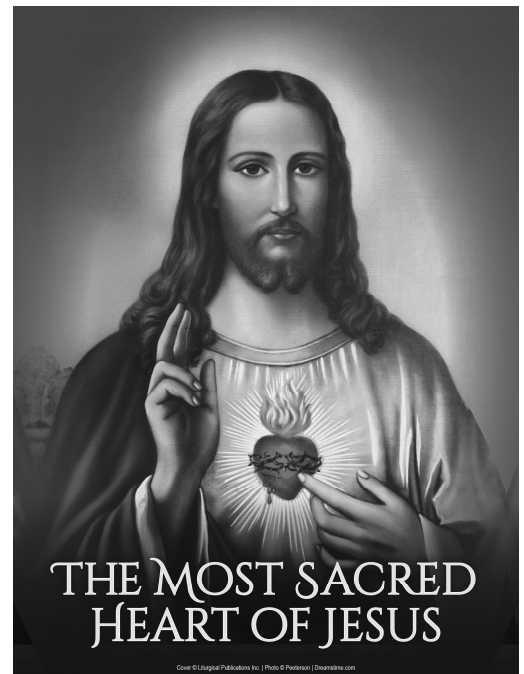

Knights of Columbus

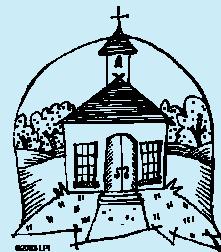

Catholic Man Night

Dear Men of the Parish:

Are you a man of hope? Are you looking for hope? 1 Peter 3:15 says:..... *Sanctify Christ as Lord of your hearts. Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope...* The hope that 1 Peter is speaking about is not confidence in human achievement or excellence.
