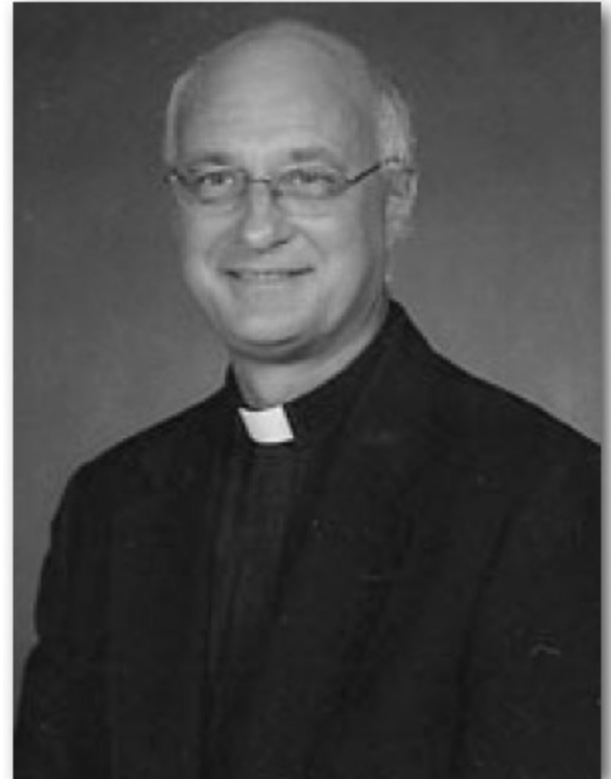

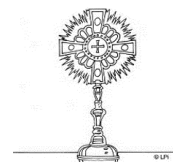

"The Joy of the Gospel: Faith Working Through Love"
Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Do you not yet have faith? Today's Gospel is the familiar story of Jesus commanding the wind and sea to be calm. We also hear in the first reading the Lord addressing Job (and us) with the reminder that He had given the sea its boundaries. God originally established the boundaries of the seas and his Son also exercised authority over them. These passages serve to develop our faith by expanding our feeble understanding of God's glory and power. Although we know and believe that we walk in God's creation, our fear often pushes our faith aside and allows us to forget God's saving power. May we live in our Savoir through service to God's children.

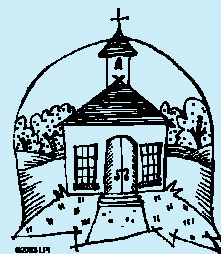

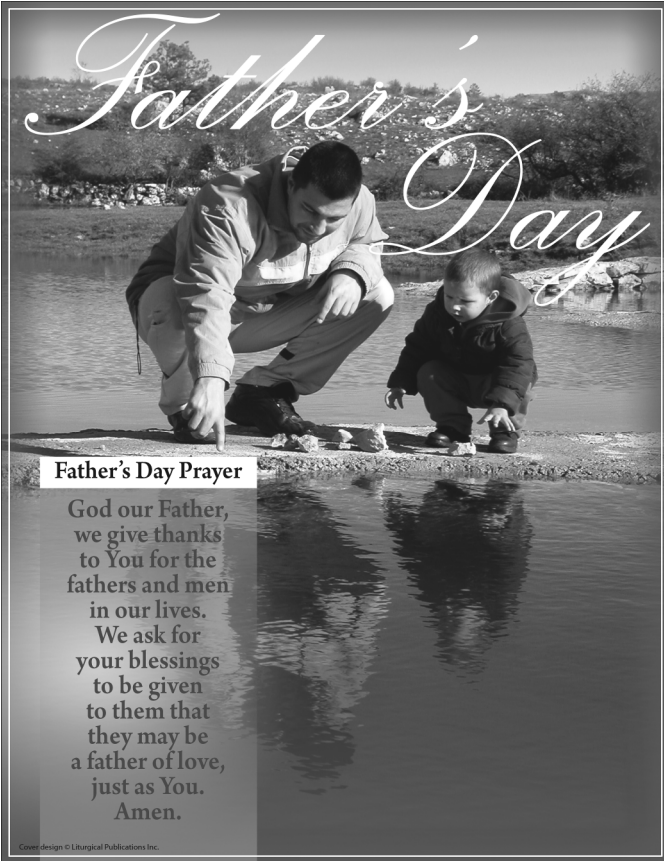
