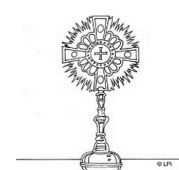

"The Joy of the Gospel: Faith Working Through Love"
Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Be opened! Today's readings tie in well with our annual stewardship theme: Faith working through Love. The first reading encourages the Israelites to have no fear for God is with them. The glory of the Lord surrounds them and today we, too, are sustained by his mercy and love. In the second reading St. James reminds us to love one another as Jesus loved us. In the Gospel the people had enough faith in Jesus to bring a deaf mute to him for healing. Jesus' love for us is displayed in his cure of the man's infirmities.
