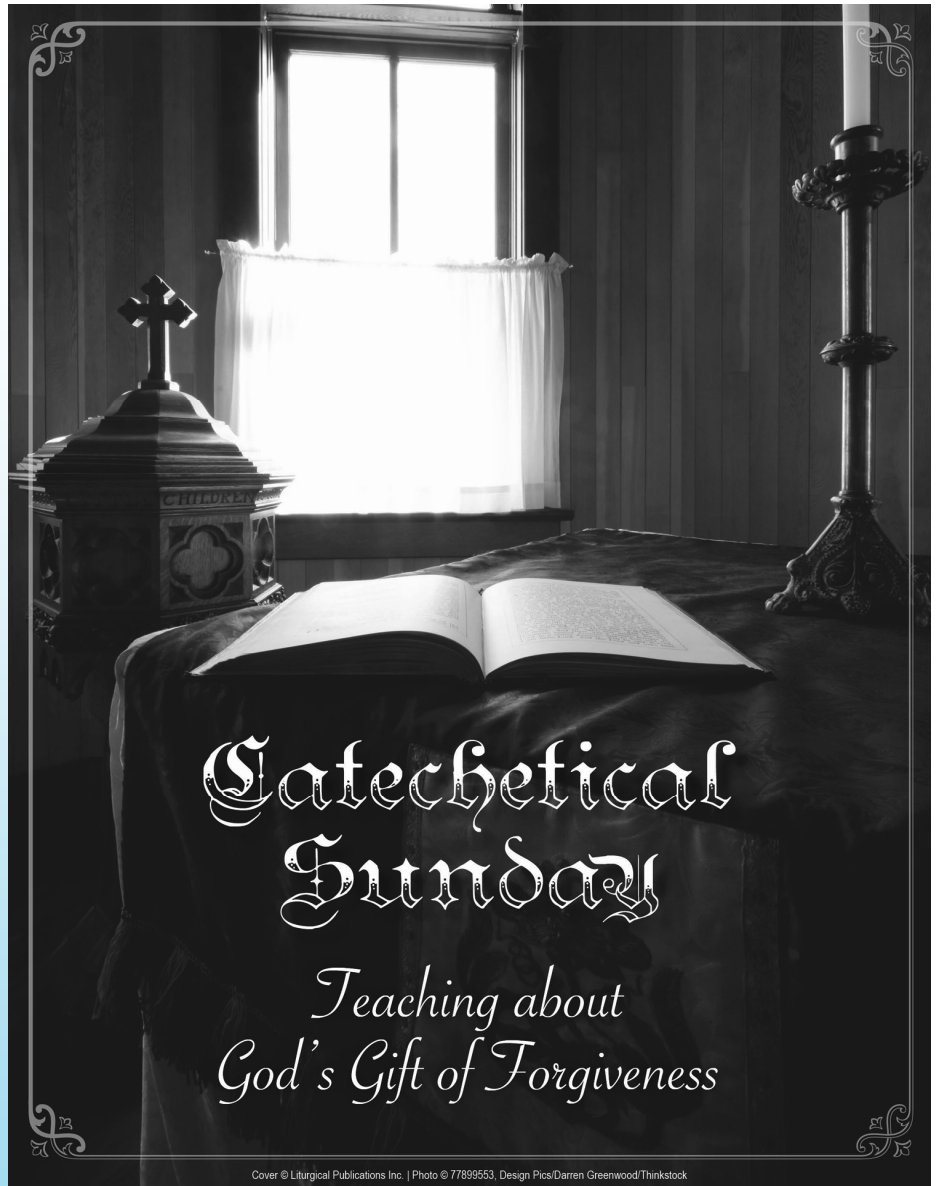

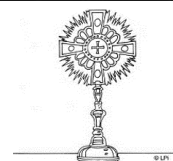

Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Lord upholds my life! By our baptism we join the Church established by Christ to bring the Gospel to all peoples. This calling invites each of us to live for the kingdom prepared by the Father. Each year we renew our commitment to live a life befitting our acceptance of the Lord's invitation. Over the next year our focus will be on the necessity of an active response exemplified by love of God and neighbor. Our reading from the Book of Wisdom today points out that a life lived according to the Gospel may subject us to rejection and ridicule. St. James tells us that a life of following God's will is a life of peace. Jesus' message is that the result of answering a call of discipleship is that we become servants of all. As our way of life takes us closer to the Kingdom of God, may we find joy in service to the Lord.

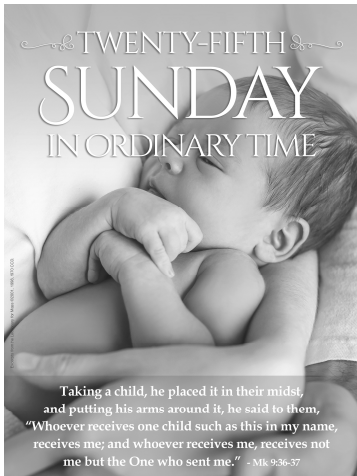

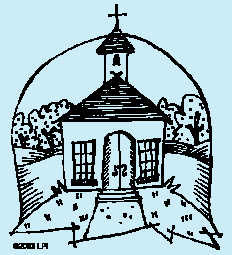
