The liturgical month of May is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

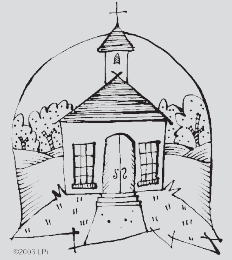
