**"Once One Chooses to be a Disciple of Christ...
Stewardship is not an Option"**

Many times in the Old Testament there are references to the Messiah. After Jesus was raised up and returned to heaven these signs were recognized by his followers and nurtured their faith. Zechariah foresaw a time when "they shall look on him whom they have pierced," a clear indication of Jesus, pierced by a soldier's lance. Signs such as these helped those in the fledgling church recognize the truth of the risen Messiah. Jesus' words take the believers to a new level, one of denying self, taking up a cross daily and following him; only by losing one's life for Jesus' sake could one be saved. May we ponder these words of Jesus with faith so that our life's journey will take us to heaven.

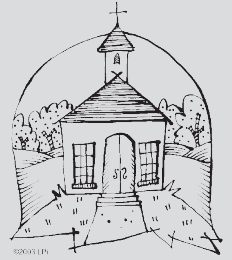
